The September Town Board Meeting was rescheduled for September 13, 2017 at 7 p.m., because of this change the minutes to that meeting will appear in the October 2017 Newsletter.

BROADBAND FOR OUR TOWNSHIP

The Committee really worked hard to make Fredenberg a top contender for the grant program for Broadband. There were 40 townships at the start and that has been shortened to only 2. Through a grassroots effort, the committee collected over 500 resident's signature on petitions in support of broadband in our township. On top of that, we got support from 11 local businesses, county commissioners, Minnesota Power and the Hermantown School District. All petitions and letter of support have been submitted to Century Link. Grant applications close September 11th. We should have some idea on what is available to our township by October 15th. Thanks to everyone who worked so hard to make this happen.

The project is progressing, we will be working throughout the fall into early winter, therefore the recreation area, including the boat launch will remain closed until then, there have been NO TRESPASSING signs posted. The area will be reopened from January 1, 2018 to June 1, 2018, then close again to complete the project. The timber harvesting being done near 1st Ave. on Bear Island Road is unrelated to the dam project.


