TOWN BOARD ACTIONS

The November

The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by Chairman Jeff Blix - 9 individuals joined the board in the Pledge of Allegiance. Minutes from last month were approved with the correction under Birch Acres Rd as a petition for a meeting about paving the road. Correspondence was reviewed and bills paid in the amount of \$20,520.84. Reports were made by the various department heads.

The clerk reported a training session for judges was held. She has fielded several questions about the early voting process.

The treasurer gave his monthly reconciliation. Total funds available as of October 13 are \$407.193.91 which included the \$80,000 in CD. The treasurer mentioned that the date on the report corresponds to the date one the bank statement.

The Road Foreman reported that we have built up the area iin the parking lot of the sledding hill and it looks good. We also added some additional dirt at the top of the hill we hope will stop them from coming down as well as on the hill. New ties and rebar were also purchased for the snow fence. The paperwork was filed for reimbursement of the July storm damage.

Fire Department and Law Enforcement - nothing to report

Cemetery - the clerk sold a plot and we have put the locks on the gates.

Parks & Rec - we are still looking

for a rink attendant. The pickle ball equipment has been stored for the season.

Community Center - the new sign has been wired. We will have the outside pump fixed for flooding the rink. The alarm that keeps going off on the septic system is due to corroded wires on the box. We also have an electrician scheduled to come in and install more outside outlets. Clay has contacted someone about the internet connections and the custodians have reported cuts in the carpet in the basement, especially close to the outside door

Recycling Center - we will be moving to not having to separate items for recycling.

Other Meetings - none. Under Old Business: - Fredenberg Lake Road - tabled.

Skating Rink - no applicants at thsi time.

Under New Business: Lawsuit - the township was served on Saturday and we have turned it in to our insurance.

Board of Canvas - meeting was set for Wednesday, Nov 9 at 7pm.

FEMA - paperwork has been submitted and we are waiting for word. Reimbursement it as 70%.

Enforcement of Ordinance -Residents asked if the park ordinance was currently being enforced.

Clay will be going to the broadband meeting.

With no further business, we adjourned at 7:45pm.


