ELECTIONS ARE COMING UP

2018 is an Election year. Minnesota State Primary is on Tuesday, August 14, 2018, voting from 7 am to 8 pm at the Fredenberg Town Hall (our polling place). Primary elections for: MN Governor & Lt. Governor, U.S. Senate, U.S. Representative, Secretary of State, State Auditor, Attorney General, State of MN Representatives and Judicial Officers, will be on the ballot.

General Elections are slated for Tuesday, November 6, 2018, voting from 7 am to 8pm at the Fredenberg Town Hall (our polling place).

Our Township will also be voting and electing 3 Town Board Supervisors in the November 6, 2018 election. Supervisor positions (4 year terms) up for election are:

Supervisor B - now held by Jeff Blix

Supervisor D - now held by Clay Cich

Supervisor E - now held by Jim Ray

Filing for Supervisors in our Township begins on Tuesday, July 31, 2018 and ends on Tuesday, August 14, 2018. You may come in anytime from 9 am to 5:30pm on **Tuesdays** to file. An Affidavit of Candidacy must be completed in person and notarized. Filing cost is \$2.

Election candidates can withdraw from participation in election by filing an Affidavit of Withdrawal, in person, at the Fredenberg Townhall Office on Thursday, August 16, 2018 from 1 to 5 pm. This must also be done in person.

RECYCLE CENTER HAZARDOUS WASTE DAY UPDATE

On Saturday, June 9, 2018, we held a Hazardous Waste Day from 11:30 am to 2:30 pm., this was in addition to that day being our normal recycle day. The response by Fredenberg residents was absolutely outstanding. Deb Pawlowicz, Supervisor, should be recognized for all the publicity and advertising she did to be sure the event was successful. So many people showed up that the Hazardous Waste people had to bring their truck down to WLSSD to unload it shortly after the program started. They ended up returning with an additional staff person, the original truck plus their "big" truck. They stated they cover Northeastern MN with the program and had never had such an overwhelming response. We even had more products than the City of Duluth that day. I stayed until 2:30pm and they registered 113 people taking advantage of the program. They told me to leave because they had to continue pouring products into barrels and would still be there for quite a few hours. One of the questions they asked, in addition to people who came to drop off their products was: "Why don't we have this every year?" With the response we had, I think this is a good question from the people.

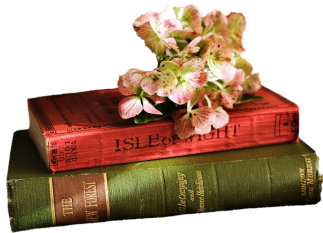
RECYCLING NEWS

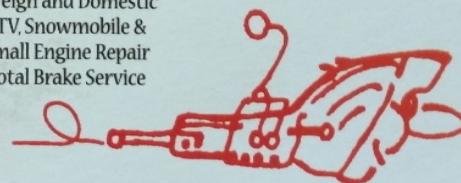

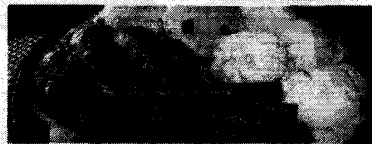
