## 4. Compensation

• The Board discussed employee hourly wage increases for 2024. There was a motion by Supervisor Cich to increase the wages across the board by 5%, except for the Recycling attendant position will stay at \$17.00/hour and will keep the additional 15 minutes at the beginning and ending shifts and seconded by Chair Wagner. There was a roll call vote and all signified affirmative. This motion was carried unanimously.
